Josef Frank's occasional table model 2168 is one of his rarer models. Its beautifully carved, turned legs give it a lighter and more playful aesthetic. The black marble top provides a considerable contrast to the walnut frame. Simplicity and exceptional quality make this piece a timeless Svenskt Tenn collectible.
