



Ceiling lamp 'Beehive' model A332 designed by Alvar Aalto for Valaistustyö Finland, 1952

Painted aluminium and polished brass.

The 'Beehive' ceiling lamp model A332 is one of Alvar Aalto's most notable lighting design. This version's rarity is due to its striking red colour, which adds a vibrant twist to Aalto's classic design. The lamp features the signature tiered form, reminiscent of a playful beehive form, made of lacquered metal with brass accents between each layer, giving it a sense of warmth and elegance. Originally designed in 1953 for Finland's University of Jyväskylä, the A332 'Beehive' lamp is celebrated for its ability to create a soft, diffused light. This effect is achieved through its layers of perforated brass rings, which allow the light to pass

through in a warm glow. Its sculptural form, reminiscent of a beehive, gives the lamp a bold aesthetic presence, making it a standout piece whether illuminated or not.
