White lacquered steel frame, wooden "shoes", chromed steel top with flag halyard.

Model presented at The Arts & Crafts Spring Exhibition at Designmuseum Danmark in 1950. This piece is one of the 1st editions of 'The Flag Halyard Chair', as the feet are wooden. Later models went on to have black rubber discs for feet. This piece is also entirely original.
